LOCAL ARTIST TO PARTNER WITH THE AMADEUS PROJECT

Collaboration to combine visual and music arts in a performance setting

Bellingham, WA. – Local painter, Yvette Neumann, and The Amadeus Project, (TAP) are partnering to bring a shared community experience to downtown Bellingham, connecting music and visual artwork.

Beginning this summer, The Amadeus Project will serve as the exclusive Gallery space for artwork produced by Neumann at Particulars Studio. A quarterly rotation of art exhibits featuring her latest work will be on permanent display in the performance hall during music performances and other events scheduled at The Amadeus Project. Neumann also has plans to stage several exclusive art events at the location throughout the year, with specific details to be announced through her website, postings at TAP, and the Bellingham Herald.

The current art exhibit includes twenty-five paintings, showcasing abstract and contemporary subjects, and explores form, color, and physical features in their primitive states. The exhibit is free and part of the monthly Bellingham Art Walk, but is also open to the public during normal TAP business hours.

“I’m not only thrilled about displaying my work at such an elegant venue, but look forward to progressing an artistic vision, that brings people together from all walks of life to enjoy interesting experiences involving multi-discipline arts” Neumann said.

The Amadeus Project is a non-profit music institution which provides a concert hall and teaching studio for the local community to experience the transcendent beauty of music and to explore their individual abilities to create authentic music. “We are thrilled with the collaboration with Particulars Studio, as it expands our artistic vision into the realm of visual arts, in addition to the aural arts”, notes Tofer Wade, TAP founder.

Neumann is the owner and operator of Particulars Studio, a fine art company specializing in original paintings, prints, and art cards. Her work will be featured at the Bellevue Arts festival, July 23rd through 25th, the Bellingham Arts Festival, July 31st through August 1st, and the Whatcom Artists Studio Tour in early October.
